The Warrens Cranberry Festival is announcing that it is accepting applications for four available scholarships through March 10, 2024. Students selected for the Festival scholarships receive \$500 toward their higher education.

The Warrens Cranberry Festival Scholarships are available to Residents of the Tomah Area School District or Alumni. The Festival selects four recipients based on academic ability and achievement, financial need, persistence, service to others, and leadership.

The Warrens Cranberry Festival Scholarships are designed to help cover students' education expenses, tuition, books, or required fees.

Berry Cranberry Magic Bars

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 1/2 cup quick oats
- 2 Tbsp. brown sugar
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 14 oz. sweetened condensed milk
- 2/3 cup dried blueberries
- 2/3 cup dried cranberries
- 1 cup white chocolate chips
- 1 cup semi sweet chocolate chips



Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 325°.
- 2. Add the butter to 9x13 pan and bake for 5 minutes at 325°. Remove from the oven and add the oatmeal, brown sugar and salt to the pan. Mix until well combined and press back into the pan. Bake an additional 5 minutes.
- 3. Top with the sweetened condensed milk, dried berries and chocolate. Bake at 325° for 25 minutes. Remove from oven and allow to cool before serving.
